Selective Membership: (https://odk.org/members/qualifications-membership/) $0\Delta K$ only accepts sophomores, juniors, seniors, and graduate student members. Undergraduates must be in the top 25% of their class. Graduate students must meet stringent criteria set by each circle. Faculty, staff, and alumni must be leaders in their field, on-campus, or in the community. Less than 5% of eligible students will ultimately receive an invitation to join. This is an honor that will serve you throughout your life.
