- · Achieved an overall grade point average (GPA) of at least a 3.0
- Achieved at least a 3.25 grade point average (GPA) in required social work courses

Graduate student requirements:

- Successfully completed at least one semester of coursework with a minimum of 6 graduate credits in social work
- · Achieved a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 3.5

Fees

The membership fee is \$30.00.
